Get Started in FIVE easy steps!



1

Start Early -

As soon as your running place has been accepted, get in touch with the fundraising team at fundraising@foreverhounds.org who will be on hand to assist you throughout your fundraising journey. The earlier you get in touch, the better we can help you and you have longer to raise money for the dogs in our care.

Create a plan -

Whether you are running a marathon, a 5K, taking part in a tough mudder or completing a triathlon, you will need an exercise plan to follow to ensure that you are ready for race day. There are plenty of FREE online tools that you can use, pick one that suits you and get all of your training days into your calendar.

Set up & Share...

Dasher's Story

Dasher was abandoned at just fourteen weeks old, along with her brother who was in very poor condition. Confused, all alone and thrown away like rubbish they were scooped up and rushed to the vets. Whilst Dasher showed signs of improvement, her brother was far too poorly and sadly didn't make it.

We care for hundreds of greyhounds and lurchers each year who need urgent medical attention, which costs the charity thousands of pounds. These costs are usually unexpected but worth every penny to make sure we can give puppies like Dasher the life she deserves. Often the rescue dogs arrive terrified. Our team make sure they have a safe space, a cosy bed and a comforting meal.

We spend a huge amount of time rebuilding their confidence after any trauma they have been through and slowly gaining their trust.

We are so glad we can be there for puppies like Dasher. We were able to find her a foster home where she can now begin to have the start in life she deserves. She has coped amazingly considering her start in life and what could have been. She is displaying natural behaviours and her playful personality is starting to shine through.

Your fundraising enables us to provide enrichment, a place to rest and as many snuggles as they like. You can help give rescue dogs hope again.

A note about the *Money*

JustGiving

All money you have raised via your JustGiving page is forwarded to us automatically, so there is nothing for you to do!

Gift Aid

If people are donating to you, ask them if they are UK taxpayers and encourage them to Gift Aid their donation. The value of their donation increases by 25% with the Gift Aid scheme, at no extra cost. Every £1 donated would be an extra 25p!

Offline Donations

If you are sending your cash donations via **post**, please make cheques payable to '**Forever Hounds Trust**' and include a note to say who it is from, your contact details, and what event it relates to. Don't forget to include original copies of any sponsor forms you have used for us to claim the Gift Aid.
